Languages of Burkina Faso

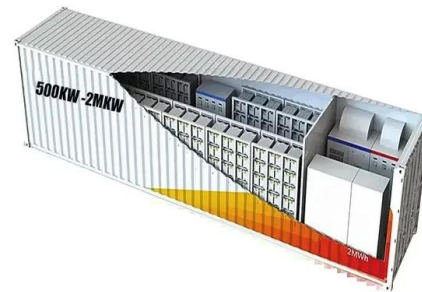
The working languages are French, which was introduced when France colonized Burkina Faso in 1919, and English. In December 2023, the government of Burkina Faso adopted a bill revising the Constitution regarding language. Indigenous languages were set as official languages, while French was made a "working

language" only. [24]

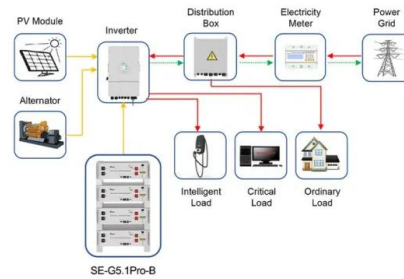
Burkina Faso

Burkina Faso [a] is a landlocked country in West Africa, [6] bordered by Mali to the northwest, Niger to the northeast, Benin to the southeast, Togo and Ghana to the south, and Ivory Coast to the southwest. It covers an area of 274,223 km² (105,878 sq mi). In 2021, the country had an estimated population of approximately 23,674,480. [14] Previously called the Republic of ...

faso between 1980 and 1990 was, according to the world bank, 80.000 to 100.000 ha. in mali, which has about the same population figure (11.9 million), living and eco logical conditions, the consumption of wood in 2000 is given as 6.5 million tons, or 1.5 kg/person/day, corresponding to 464.285 ha



Application scenarios of energy storage battery products

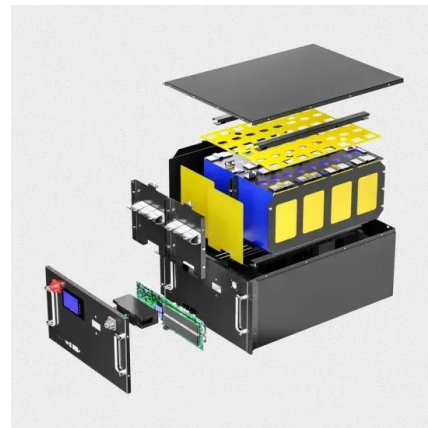


BURKINA FASO: A Solar Panel Production Plant Built in Ouagadougou

Named "Faso Energy", the plant was inaugurated on September 22, 2020 by the Burkinabe Prime Minister Christophe Joseph Marie Dabiré. According to this official, the facility will promote the acquisition of solar energy equipment by the population, thus reducing the need to increase the rate of access to electricity in Burkina Faso.

Burkina Faso

Burkina Faso has made remarkable progress in recent years, with an increase in installed capacity from 324.6 megawatts (MW) in 2017 to 410 megawatts in 2019. The share of renewable energy also surged from 9.4% in 2015 to 18.36% in 2019. For 2020, the Government is targeting an installed capacity of 1,000 MW, of which 50% will be renewable



Burkina Faso

Burkina Faso is also a member of the Intergovernmental Action Group against Money Laundering in West Africa (GIABA), a FATF-style regional body. Burkina Faso has been on the FATF Grey List since approximately 2021, but the

country has prioritized the strengthening of its Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorism Financing (AML/CTF) regimes.
