## Overview

---

How do the Cocos (Keeling) Islands communicate?

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands have access to a range of modern communication services. Digital television stations are broadcast from Western Australia via satellite. A local radio station, 6CKI – Voice of the Cocos (Keeling) Islands, is staffed by community volunteers and provides some local content.

Why are the Cocos Islands called the Keeling Islands?

The territory's dual name (official since the islands' incorporation into Australia in 1955) reflects that the islands have historically been known as either the Cocos Islands or the Keeling Islands. The territory consists of two atolls made up of 27 coral islands, of which only two – West Island and Home Island – are inhabited.

Where can I watch the Cocos (Keeling) Islands?

It is available in paper and electronic formats. The Cocos (Keeling) Islands receives a range of digital channels from Western Australia via satellite and is broadcast from the Airport Building on the West Island on the following VHF frequencies: ABC6, SBS7, WAW8, WOW10 and WDW11.

What is the capital of Cocos (Keeling) Islands?

The capital of the Territory of Cocos (Keeling) Islands is West Island while the largest settlement is the village of Bantam, on Home Island. Governance of the islands is based on the Cocos (Keeling) Islands Act 1955 and depends

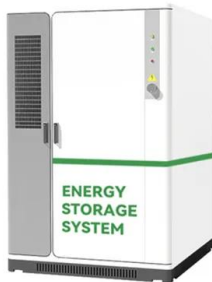
heavily on the laws of Australia.

What power does Western Australia have over the Cocos Islands?

The Act also gives Western Australian courts judicial power over the islands. The Cocos Islands remain constitutionally distinct from Western Australia, however; the power of the state to legislate for the territory is power-delegated by the federal government.

### Climate and Average Weather Year Round in Cocos Islands

A wet day is one with at least 0.04 inches of liquid or liquid-equivalent precipitation. The chance of wet days in Cocos Islands varies significantly throughout the year. The wetter season lasts 6.1 months, from January 16 to July 20, with a greater than 28% chance of a given day being a wet day. The month with the most wet days in Cocos Islands is March, with an average of 13.6 ...

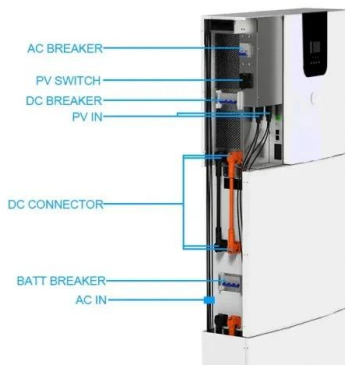


### September Weather in Cocos Islands Cocos (Keeling) Islands

Over the course of September in Cocos Islands, the length of the day is gradually increasing om the start to the end of the month, the length of the day increases by 19 minutes, implying an average daily increase of 40 seconds, and weekly increase of 4 minutes, 37 seconds.. The shortest day of the month is September 1, with 11 hours, 53 minutes of daylight and the ...

## Cocos (Keeling) Islands

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands are a group of 27 islands, and are composed of 2 atolls: North Keeling, and South Keeling. South Keeling consists of 26 islands in a horseshoe formation around a large lagoon (approximately 10 km across).

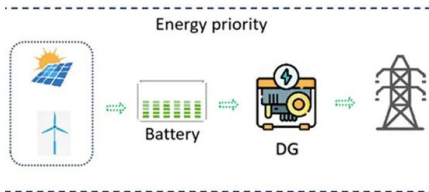

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands consist of two flat, low-lying coral atolls with an area of 14.2 square kilometres (5.5 sq mi), 26 kilometres (16 mi) of coastline, a highest elevation of 5 metres (16 ft) and thickly covered with coconut palms and other vegetation.
