Does the Cook Islands have solar power?

The Cook Islands Electricity Sector historically been powered by diesel generators. Since around 2011, increasing solar PV generation on Rarotonga has changed this situation. And in 2014- 15, installation of 95-100% renewable solar hybrid systems on the Northern Group Islands further altered the mix.

How much energy does the Cook Islands use?

The Cook Islands is a net importer of energy, in the form of petroleum products. Total energy consumption was 1,677,278,000 BTU (1.77 TJ) in 2017, of which 811,000,000 (0.86 TJ) was in the form of oil. In 2012 47% of imported oil was used in the transport sector, 30% in aviation, and 27% for electricity generation.

Why do Cook Islands residents need a full-time power system?

And with local residents trained during the installation process, the community is empowered to maintain and operate the systems themselves. Now with full-time power, the future has taken a new shape for Cook Islands' residents – an improved quality of life, and increased economy activity.

How did we help the Cook Islands Government achieve its aim?

We helped the government realise its aim. To support the Cook Islands Government, the New Zealand Government – through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, installed mini-grid photo-voltaic power systems in a number of villages on six remote islands. Is full-time power the future of Cook Islands?

Now with full-time power, the future has taken a new shape for Cook Islands' residents – an improved quality of life, and increased economy activity. The improved livelihood in the communities that now have the benefit of reliable, 24hour power supply is immeasurable.

Why is there no electricity on the islands?

Bad weather and other events often prevent goods arriving on the islands. Previously, electricity was provided by diesel generators, usually for around 12 hours per day. Power supply was effected by issues of reliability, maintainability, capacity and access to adequate, regular diesel supplies.

Cook Islands October Weather, Average Temperature (Cook Islands)

Over the course of October in Cook Islands, the length of the day is increasing on the start to the end of the month, the length of the day increases by 35 minutes, implying an average daily increase of 1 minute, 10 seconds, and weekly increase of 8 minutes, 13 seconds.. The shortest day of the month is October 1, with 12 hours, 18 minutes of daylight ...

New Zealand company completes solar project in Cook Islands

Infratec Chief Executive Greg Visser said the four solar plants were now providing clean, reliable and affordable energy to almost 1500 people - or about 9 percent of the Cook Islands' population. The solar panels, which are backed by battery storage, will meet about 95 percent of the islands' energy needs, he said.



Renewable energy 2030 commitment

At the 2022 United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP27) it was reported that the Cook Islands has converted 13 of its 15 islands to solar energy and set a target of 2025 for the remaining two. The target was revised to 2030 in September last year by director of Renewable Energy Development, Tangi Tereapii.

Electricity in Cook Islands in 2022

As of 2022, the state of electricity consumption in the Cook Islands illustrates a balanced yet elementary mix of energy sources.



Approximately half of the electricity generated comes from low-carbon sources, with solar energy contributing entirely to this segment. The other half is derived from fossil fuels, indicating that the Cook Islands is equally dependent on high-emission energy.

Cook Islands On Target To Be 100 Percent Renewable

The Asian Development Bank and the European Union have together contributed more than \$18m to get solar projects off the ground, while the islands' government has added \$5.83m. To support this ambitious plan the Asian Development Bank and the European Union fund the Cook Islands Renewable Energy Sector Project, which will construct up to six solar photovoltaic (PV) power plants with a total installed capacity of about 3 megawatts-peak coupled with battery to store electricity from solar energy.
