Do I need a plug for St Martin?

Standard US plugs and appliances are compatible too. On the other side, St Martin (French side) has a 220 voltage at 60 Hz. French plugs are required. It is highly recommended to bring a transformer plug with you to adapt to any side of the island.

What voltage does St Martin have?

On the other side, St Martin (French side) has a 220 voltage at 60 Hz. French plugs are required. It is highly recommended to bring a transformer plug with you to adapt to any side of the island. Make sure you check what the voltage is before plugging in your electronics if they do not automatically convert the current themselves!.

Does Dutch St Maarten have a 110 volt AC outlet?

A few hotels and villas include 110 AC outlets in the bathrooms, and some may have transformers to loan to guests. All appliances require standard two-prong French plugs or appropriate adaptors. Dutch St. Maarten operates on 110 volt AC, 60 cycles with American-style plugs.

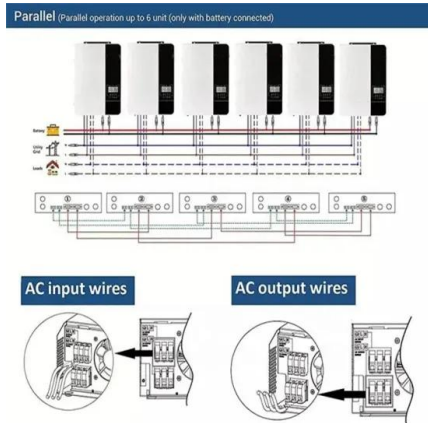

When you are in St. Martin, dial 0-590 + the local six digit number for local calls and 0-690 + the local six digit number for local calls to cell phones. To call Dutch St. Maarten from the US, dial 1-721 followed by the seven digit local number.

Electricity and Water in St. Martin/St. Maarten

Dutch Side (Sint Maarten): The electricity standard aligns with the United States, operating at 110 volts and 50 Hz, compatible with standard US plugs and appliances . French Side (Saint-Martin): In contrast, the French side uses a 220-voltage system at 60 Hz, requiring French plugs. Visitors are advised to bring a transformer plug or adapter.

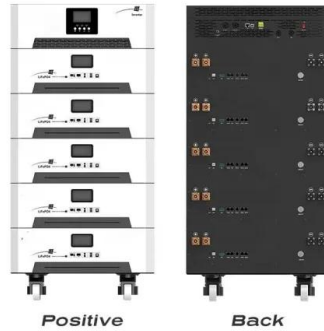

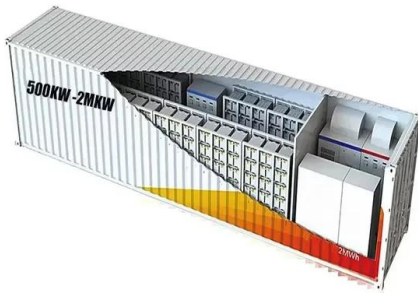

Electrical Outlets in St. Martin and St. Maarten: What You Need to ...

To sum up, St. Martin uses European-style 220-240V electricity and Type C/E plugs, while St. Maarten uses U.S.-style 110-120V electricity and Type A/B plugs. For those staying at one of

the many luxury rental properties offered by Sotheby's, you'll often find both plug types available, or the option to use an adapter provided by the property.
