Equatorial Guinea is the ninth-largest producer of crude oil in Africa, after Ghana in 2018. Foreign investment, primarily by U.S. companies, have poured into the country's oil sector in recent years. The Zafiro field is Equatorial Guinea's largest oil producer, with output rising from 7,000 bbl/d in 1996 to approximately 280,000 bbl/d by 2004.

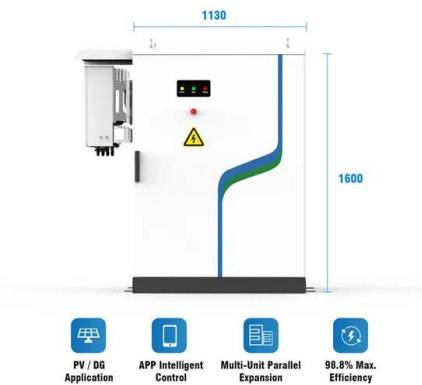
Equatorial Guinea To Add 20,000 Barrels Per Day Of Oil

"We expect an increase this year of around 20,000 bbl/d additional because of the new discoveries," Gabriel Obiang Lima told reporters on the sidelines of an energy event.

Equatorial Guinea has announced plans to develop energy projects worth US\$1bn, including two new oil refineries. The first modular refinery would have a capacity of 20,000 bbl/d and transforms crude oil from Zafiro and Aseng fields.

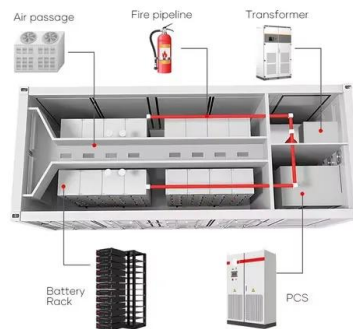
Equatorial Guinea exports around 300,000 bbl/d of oil, about one-third of which is destined for North American Markets. According to the Oil and Gas Journal, Equatorial Guinea had proved oil reserves of 1.1 billion barrels as of January 2011. The majority of these reserves are located

offshore in the oil-rich Gulf of Guinea.

Exxon Mobil to Exit Equatorial Guinea Amid Wider Africa

Exxon Mobil's oil output in Equatorial Guinea, a member of OPEC, peaked at more than 300,000 bbl/d eight years ago and has been declining since. Exxon Mobil has been trying to sell its Zafiro operation since 2020. The company last year pumped about 45,000 bbl/d in Equatorial Guinea, out of the country's total production of 93,000 bbl/d.

Panoro updates drilling goals offshore Gabon, Equatorial Guinea

Panoro Energy expects the first of two new infill wells in Block 6 offshore Equatorial Guinea to come onstream early next month.. Drilling is taking place on the Ceiba field and offshore Okume complex. Initial results from the first well look promising, the company said in a trading update, with the second well set to be completed and onstream in October.
