Gabon CO<sub>2</sub> Fuel Combustion/CO<sub>2</sub> Emissions. In its NDC (2016), Gabon set the commitment to reduce its GHG emissions by at least 50% in 2025 as compared to a BAU scenario, including LULUCF (Land Use, Land-Use Change and Forestry), which accounts for more than 60% of direct emissions, but excluding carbon stocks in forests (i.e. sinks).

The country's two main energy sources are fossil-fuels and hydropower. 51.7% of Gabon's total produced electricity in 2015 were generated from hydro, and 48.2% were from fossil fuels. Gabon relies heavily on oil for both its export revenues & its domestic energy production.

## Gabon

The crude oil output in Gabon steadily increased in recent years, reaching 226,000 barrels per day in the first quarter of 2024, up from 214,000 b/d and 205,000 b/d in 2023 and 2022, respectively. The main reason behind this growth is the production kickoff from the Hibiscus/Ruche project adding 20,000 b/d between between 2023 and early 2024.
