Once you crack the seal of the pouch, we recommend using your pods up within 2 weeks and that you store them in a dry, dark place (direct sunlight is also bad for coffee – precious little flower is).

Unopened boxes of coffee pods usually have a shelf life of 10 to 18 months to preserve them. How long should coffee pods be stored?

Do not store your coffee pods for longer than the recommended time frame. Over time, the flavor of the coffee pods will degrade and become stale. – Do not store your coffee pods in a plastic bag or container. This can cause the pods to become stale more quickly due to air and moisture.
