products behind the bathroom window to avoid the sun's UV rays to attack them.

How do I keep my shower gel fresh?

Here are some things you can do to keep your shower gel fresh and usable for longer: Store it in a cool, dry place away from sunlight and moisture. Heat and humidity can cause degradation of the product, reducing its effectiveness. Use a pump dispenser instead of opening the bottle every time you need to use it.

Does shower gel have a preservative?

Most store-bought shower gels, however, will have some sort of preservative element. If you've opened your shower gel, it immediately starts aging. Once the seal is broken, bacteria can get in and can begin breeding if you let it. Plus, ingredients begin evaporating and the aging process begins. Pay attention to the PAO label on the container.

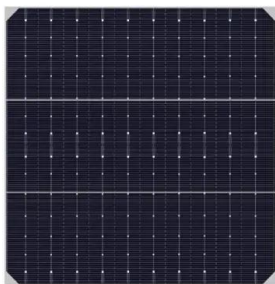
