What is a solar cost calculator?

Our solar cost calculator is a great tool for getting a sense of how much solar costs and how much you can save by going solar. However, every calculator is limited by its assumptions and its results should be taken with a grain of salt.

How much does a solar loan cost per watt?

Solar loans will increase your price per watt. The average cost for solar panels financed with a solar loan is between \$3.80 and \$4.25 per watt because of financing fees. Don't be surprised when you get a quote that seems high if it includes a solar loan!.

How much does a 5000 watt solar system cost?

A fully installed solar system typically costs \$3 to \$5 per watt before incentives like the 30% tax credit are applied. Using this measurement, 5,000 Watt solar system (5 kW) would have a gross cost between \$15,00 and \$25,000. The price per watt for larger and relatively straightforward projects are often within the \$3-\$4 range.
