Overview

What is the community solar program in New Mexico?

The community solar program in New Mexico is still under development. The Community Solar Act, or SB84, was signed into law in April 2021 by Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham. A community-based solar project could benefit individuals, businesses, nonprofits and other groups, who don't have access to energy from solar installations.

What is the largest solar project in Mexico?

It will be the largest solar project built by Mexico's state-owned electric company. In Puerto Peñasco, near the top of the Gulf of California and border with Arizona, rows of solar panels that tilt with the passing sun run off to the horizon hovering above the sand.

How many large-scale solar projects are being built in Mexico?

In Mexico this year, around 14 large-scale solar projects are either in operation, in the latter stages of development, or still waiting for permits to begin construction.

Who receives a bill credit for a solar facility?

Subscribers to the facility receive a bill credit for the electricity generated in proportion to the subscriber's share of the facility's kilowatt-hour output; Subscribing Organization owns or operates the solar facility. New Mexico Public Regulation Commission expands community solar ...

In 2021, the New Mexico Legislature passed Senate Bill 84, establishing the state's community solar program. Sponsored by Senator Elizabeth "Liz" Stefanics (D-Bernalillo), the bill authorized 200 MW of community solar projects, enough to power 38,000 homes.

The New Mexico Legislature established its community solar program in 2021 via Senate Bill 84, which authorized 200 MW of community solar projects, enough to power about 38,000 homes. The legislation also granted the PRC the authority and direction to approve additional program capacity, to be implemented by November 1, 2024.
