Open circuit voltage of solar panels



Overview

Here is the setup of a solar panel: Every solar panel is comprised of PV cells, connected in series. Each PV cell produces anywhere between 0.5V and 0.6V, according to Wikipedia; this is known as Open-Circuit Voltage or V_{OC} for short. All the PV cells in all solar panels have the same 0.58V voltage. .

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Open-circuit voltage (V_{oc}) is the maximum voltage a solar panel can produce when it is not connected to a load or operating circuit.

The open circuit voltage is the maximum voltage that the solar panel can produce with no load on it (i.e. measured with a multimeter across the open ends of the wires attached to the panel).

Open Circuit Voltage is a key term in solar tech. It's the voltage when no power flows. You'll find that V_{OC} typically falls between 21.7V to 43.2V.

The open-circuit voltage is a representation of the level of forward bias on the solar cell, resulting from the junction bias between the solar cell and the current generated by the sunlight.
