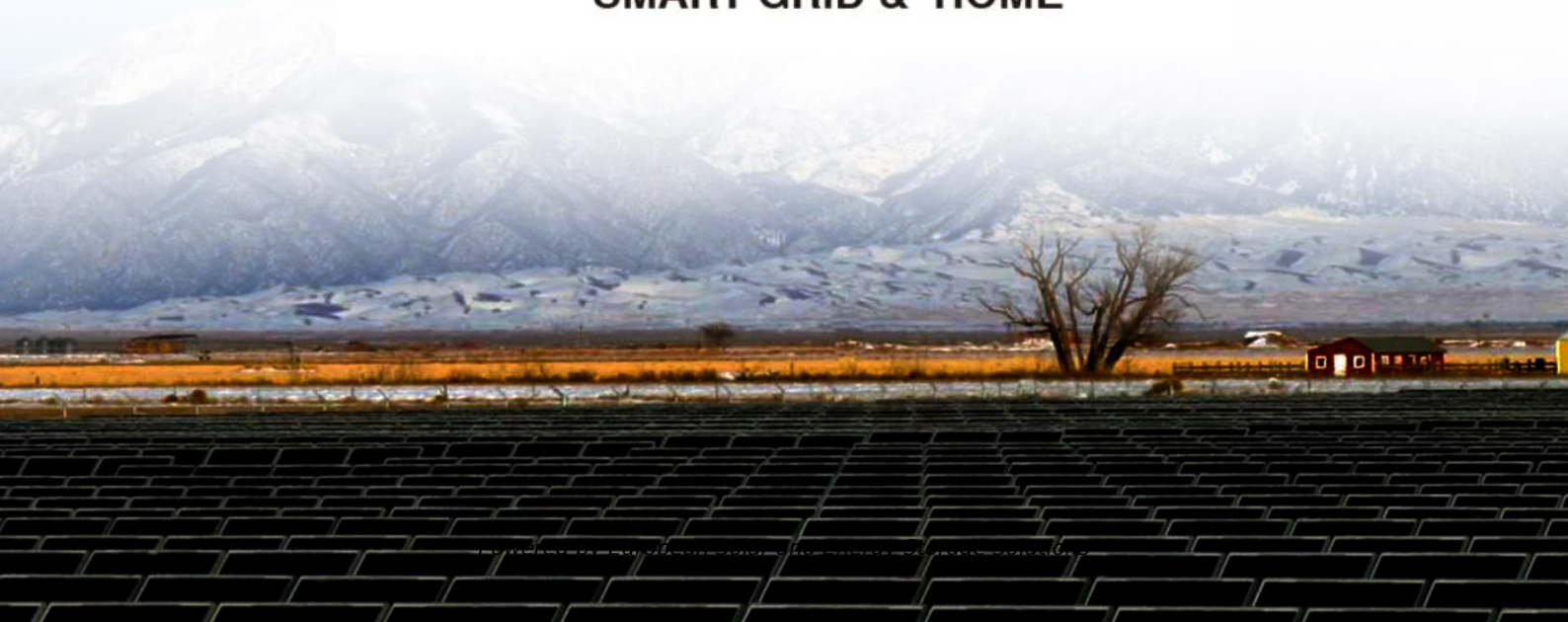

Are solar panels noisy?

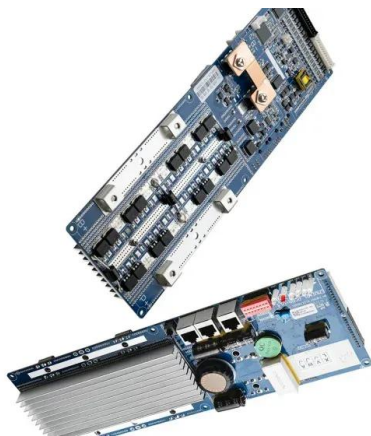

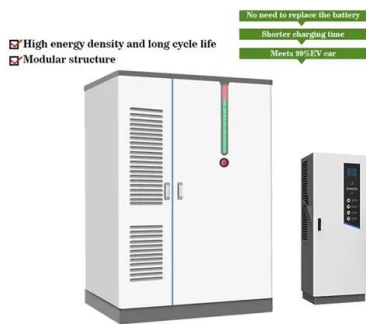

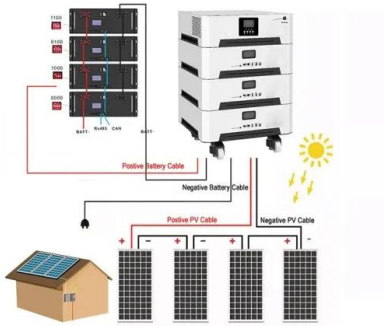
