What is Dragon Boat Festival?

The English language name for the holiday is "Dragon Boat Festival", used as the official English translation of the holiday by the People's Republic of China. It is also referred to in some English sources as Double Fifth Festival which alludes to the day of the festival according to the Chinese calendar.

Why is Longzhou Jie called Dragon Boat Festival?

It is called Dragon Boat Festival, or Longzhou Jie (龙舟节) in Chinese, because of its close association with dragon boats. Chinese people attach great cultural significance to dragons. The two main activities during the festival are eating zongzi (rice dumplings) and boat races, and both are related to dragons.

Why was Dragon Boat Festival changed in the Han dynasty?

In the Han Dynasty, due to the unification of the north and the south, the calendar changed. In order to facilitate the festival, the imperial court stipulated that the annual Dragon Boat Festival should be changed to the fifth day of the fifth month of the lunar calendar.

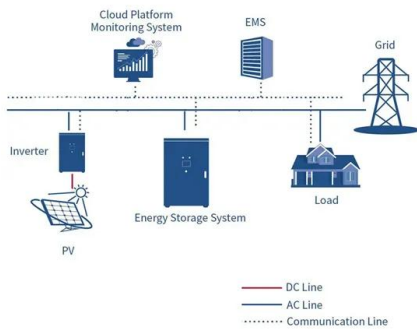

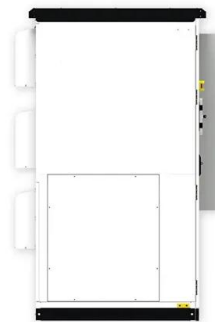

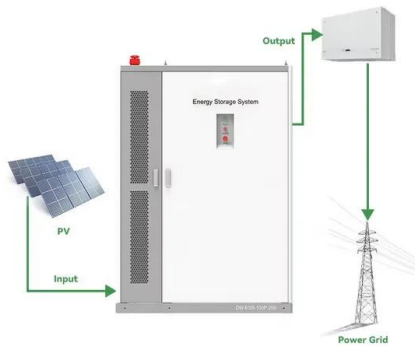
