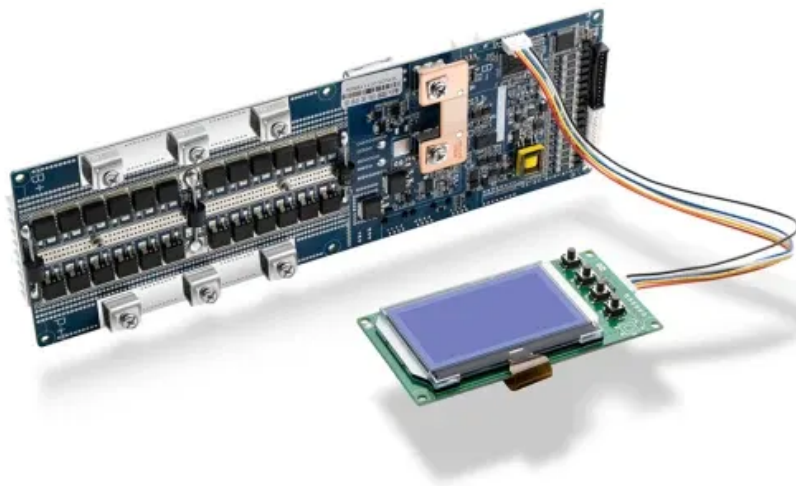

How is French Guiana navigable?

Ask first to be sure but the boatmen are a co-operative and the price is fixed for everyone. 3,400km of French Guiana's waterways are navigable by native boats called pirogues. 460km is navigable by small ocean-going vessels and coastal and river steamers. There is limited public transport throughout the territory.

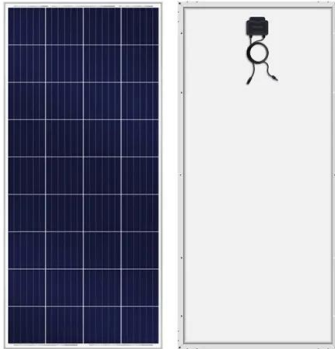
