Overview

How many rhinos have been poached in South Africa in 2023?

In other parts of South Africa however, it is a different picture. The vast majority of poaching in the country in 2023 (65%) occurred in the province of KwaZulu-Natal, which had an alarming 325 rhinos poached - 307 of those deaths occurred in just one state run park, Hluhluwe iMfolozi.

How many rhinos are left in Africa today?

A huge rise in poaching for rhino horn and the steady increase of habitat loss over the last 50 years has decimated rhino populations in Africa with approximately 23, 885 rhinos across the two African species (white rhino and black rhino) left in the wild today.

Is the Kruger a hot spot for rhino poaching?

Once a hot spot for rhino poaching in South Africa, the Kruger has seen a decrease of poaching in the last few years with the 2023 poaching numbers (78 rhinos killed) decreasing by 37% from 2022.

You can find out more about these important black rhino range expansions here. The Zululand Rhino Orphanage is the only dedicated rhino rescue and rehabilitation facility in KwaZulu-Natal (KZN), the current global epicentre of rhino poaching in South Africa.

How many rhinos are in Kruger National Park?

From a population of around 10 000 white rhinos and 600 black rhinos in 2010, the numbers are now down to approximately 3 549 white rhinos and 268 black rhinos. Most rhinos were poached in Kruger National Park. If this trend continues, the entire rhino population currently protected by Kruger might be wiped out by 2030.
