Can a floor support the weight of a fish tank?

A floor that can support a human does not necessarily support the weight of a fish tank. The other top answer suggests that this rule of thumb holds true, but it doesn't in general due to the difference between live and static loads. A

person is a live load, meaning they move around and are not constantly weighing down on one point.

How big a tank should a aquarium stand be?

A stand usually has space built-in below the aquarium that can be used to conceal equipment and store accessory items. As a general rule of thumb, tanks under 20 gallons can be placed on a sturdy desk or a well-secured solid shelf. When setting up aquariums larger than that, it is advisable to consider a dedicated aquarium stand.

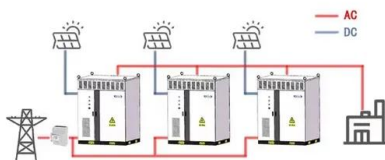
