More than 30 people were killed by the two waves of explosions, and thousands were injured, around 300 critically. According to the state-run National News Agency, solar energy systems also.

Lebanon's National News Agency (NNA) has reported that solar panels and walkie-talkies used by the Hezbollah militant group exploded on Wednesday, following a wave of pager explosions the day before. The agency reported explosions of rooftop solar systems in several parts of Beirut, but did not provide additional details.

Who is responsible for Israel's exploding solar panels?

Most of the impacted devices appeared to be communication systems, but there were also some reports of other devices exploding, like solar panels. At

least one such explosion injured a girl. Hezbollah and the Lebanese government have blamed Israel for the explosions. Israel has not commented.

Did a solar system explode in Nabatieh?

He believes that what probably happened in Nabatieh, in southern Lebanon, on Wednesday was not the solar system itself that exploded but rather a walkie-talkie device near it, adding that he did not hear of other systems exploding in other areas or getting hacked. "A solar system can not explode unless there are explosives in it," he said.

Did Israel cause solar panels to burst into flames?

Claim: Other social media users insinuated that Israel had caused solar panels to burst into flames. "Lebanon: Sabotaged solar panels have started significant electrical fires. Over 500 individuals have been reported injured so far", this user wrote featuring an Israeli flag. Attached was an image of burning solar panels and a house on fire.

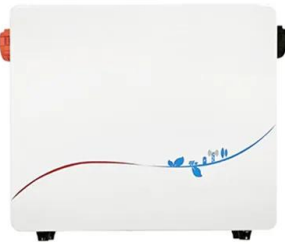
Can a solar system explode?

"A solar system can not explode unless there are explosives in it," he said. He also said that it is highly improbable that the systems were hacked especially since a hacker needs to work on each system separately.

Are solar panels exploding in Lebanon?

DW Fact check: False. There are no documented cases of exploding solar panels in the current attacks in Lebanon. The image is a collage of two old pictures.
