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In 2014, Imperial College predicted that Britain could have 40% of electricity from solar power in sunny days by 2020 in 10 million homes compared to a half a million homes in start of 2014. If a third of households would generate solar energy it could equal 6% of British total electricity consumption.

Between 2010 and 2015, solar power in the UK benefitted from feed-in-tariffs—guaranteed prices for power generation. In this period, British commercial utility-scale solar power grew at a fast pace. What percentage of UK electricity is generated by solar?

The most recent data says that solar accounts for around 4% of Britain's total electricity generation, up from 3.1% in 2016. Solar power is the third most generated renewable energy in the UK, after wind energy and biomass. The UK is the third largest producer of solar energy in the EU, behind Germany and Italy.

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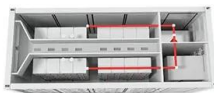
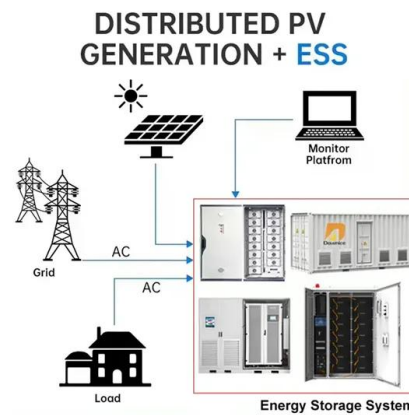
